Additional Information:

* **There is open play for members every day from dawn to dusk. Even during instructional periods one court will usually be available for games.**

Experienced Players are asked to team up with other members for the Hi/Lo Guided Play and mentoring. I.e. “Let me show you how to make a good full roll shot.” Or: “What do I do if blue blocks the first wicket and I am playing red?” Etc. **This is our premier club bonding and building time; hi and lo are relative of course: if a 15 handicap player is there with a 12 handicap player, the 12 is the “pro”, if a 12 with an 8, the 8 is the pro, if an 8 with a minus 1.5 (wonder who that could be?) , then the 8 is the amateur, etc. This is the time for higher handicappers to ask questions of the more experienced players as well as play with them in a relaxed atmosphere of social play and cooperation in learning more about the game. Make being there then a top priority if at all possible. Remember: we can accommodate up to 16 players using both courts!

- Court Mowing is normally scheduled for early morning on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday

- Full Sized Court will be set up for play on Wednesdays and Thursdays all day.

- Randall McAndrew will coordinate the Golf Croquet Program. Please assist when asked.

- Court is open from dawn to dusk for members, 9-5 for rental.
- Open play for members is available every day with the exceptions for special events as noted on the schedule.
